


# IFD funding & funding rates in international projects

IFD funding to DK partners in international projects: €300.000 per DK partner & up to €500.000 for all partners. It is generally recommended to include a DK university or GTS partner and a DK user or industrial partner in each project.

In some calls a DK industrial partner is mandatory.

IFD can as a maximum fund 75% of total project costs (Danish+foreign)
